\$100-1,000

Contribution levels are based upon one of the following OR number of employees, whichever is less.
 ✓ for-profit organizations as revenue OR
 ✓ not-for-profit organizations as budget
 (For example, if your organization's budget/revenue is \$5MM yet you only have 40 employees, base your contribution level on employees.)

Basic Associates at \$1,000 contribution level may also participate in Volunteer Central's Advisory Council for networking and presentations by expert and visionary speakers as well as information on Tulsa area volunteer needs and accomplishments.

Volunteer Central Services also available to non-Associates on an as-needed/usage basis.

These fees would apply to non-associates who wish to participate in the Volunteer Central programs and services. The fee structure is not designed to re-capture the total cost, yet encourages efficient and effective use by the customer organization. Organizations receiving benefits can help defray the cost and that it is not reasonable or fair to ask volunteers to also pay the cost of finding a place to serve.
